

Chairman Marc G. Dubin, M.D., F.A.C.S.



Dr. Dubin's health care leadership collectively spans over 10 years, including chairing the 60-physician Centers for Advanced ENT Care (CAdENT), the Mid-Atlantic's largest provider of ENT services. He has been on the Board of the American Rhinologic society and currently is a course director for the American Rhinologic Society's Summer Sinus Symposium. Previously he served as medical director of the Sherwood Surgical Center at the Greater Baltimore Medical Center.

In 2006, Dr. Dubin joined Ear Nose and Throat Associates at GBMC, which became a division of CAdENT in 2017. He continues to practice as a subspecialist in Rhinology (nasal and sinus surgery) and is a sought-after expert in his field including instructing other physicians in advanced sinus surgery at national and international courses and consulting with myriad medical technology companies. He has published over 27 articles in peer-reviewed journals, authored several textbook chapters, and applied for a sinus surgical instrumentation patent.

Dr. Dubin earned a medical degree at the University of Pennsylvania and trained in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. After further training under renowned sinus specialist Dr. Frederick Kuhn, he joined the Department of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, where he practiced full time until August 2006 and maintains an assistant professorship. He lives with his family in Towson, MD and is a member of the American Academy of Otolaryngology, American Rhinologic Society and the Mary Society of Otolaryngology.
